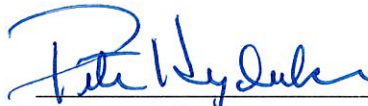
Councilor Fosso, supported by Councilor Hildenbrand, moved to approve the 2024 Transient Merchant Application of I Heart Cookies.
