- **Kyle Bender**

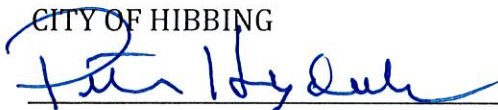
DISCUSSION: Councilor Bayliss spoke about Kyle Bender's public forum. There was a brief discussion between City Councilors and Staff regarding this topic.
