Public Safety Building Architecture and Engineering Discussion

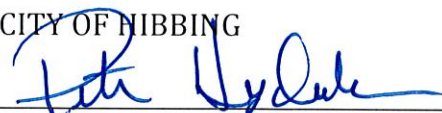
